The Arc's National Convention is our main event for the disability community.

We bring together our chapter network, advocates, people with disabilities, family members, researchers, and disability professionals to:

- shape future leaders,
- share best practices,
- inspire innovation,
- energize advocates, and
- celebrate our diversity.

Over the course of three days, Convention attendees:

- share and learn from each other,
- form new and lasting friendships, and
- attend thought-provoking and motivating sessions.

We are looking for people to present at the National Convention!

We welcome presenters who:

- Are part of The Arc's chapter network, people with disabilities, family members, disability professionals, or researchers.
- Will share high quality content that reflects [The Arc's mission](#).

We especially would like presenters from diverse backgrounds.

SESSION THEMES

We invite proposals for breakout sessions that are **60 minutes long**. We encourage about 45 minutes of content and 15 minutes for questions from the audience.

Presentation proposals should fall into one of the themes listed below:

1. **Organizational and Professional Development:** New strategies and tools to strengthen and support chapters' work and help individuals to grow and learn.
2. **Advancing Access, Equity, and Inclusion:** Ways to better understand and support people who have multiple marginalized identities.
3. **Innovative Programs and Direct Services:** New ways to support people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) to live their best lives.
4. **Advocacy and Self-Advocacy:** Strategies and tools for mobilizing people to share their stories and drive change.
5. **Public Policy:** Trends in federal and state legislation that effects people with IDD and their families.

Interesting topics for attendees include:

- Leadership and organizational development
- Modern service models in employment, housing, enabling technology, and community involvement
- Public policy and grassroots advocacy
- Finding new workers, hiring workers, and keeping them
- Criminal justice reform
- Access, equity, and inclusion
- Inclusive education
- Fundraising strategies and new funding models

All presentations and presenters must be in person (no remote options).

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The same proposal may not be submitted more than one time.
- Sessions cannot sell or market a specific product or service.
- All mandatory sections of the proposal application must be completed to be considered for acceptance (these will have a "*" by the question).

GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTED PRESENTERS

Presentation Guidelines:

- **Presenters must be in person. There is no virtual component for this event.**
- Presenters are responsible for preparing all materials for their session (PowerPoint presentations, handouts, etc.).
- **Presenters must use the approved 2024 National Convention PowerPoint template (will be provided)**
- Materials should be accessible, equitable, and inclusive (helpful guidance and resources will be shared with all presenters).
- All presentations must adhere to The Arc's Language & Style guidelines and Usage agreements. All presentations must be consistent with The Arc's [Core Values](#) and [Position Statements](#).

- Presenters must submit their completed PowerPoint presentations by **October 4, 2024**. Presentations will be reviewed for accessibility before they are made available to attendees. Please note that this may result in changes to submitted materials.
- Presenters are responsible for printing their own materials. Shipping information will be shared with presenters weeks before the 2024 National Convention
- All presentations will be made available to conference participants through the National Convention app.

Financial Guidelines:

- The Arc does not pay people to present at The Arc National Convention.
- Presenters need to make their own hotel and travel arrangements.
- Presenters will get **\$75** off registration to attend The Arc's 2024 National Convention.

The proposal submission deadline is May 5, 2024.

Speakers will be notified via email of final decisions by June 14, 2024.
